Case study analyses are encouraged.

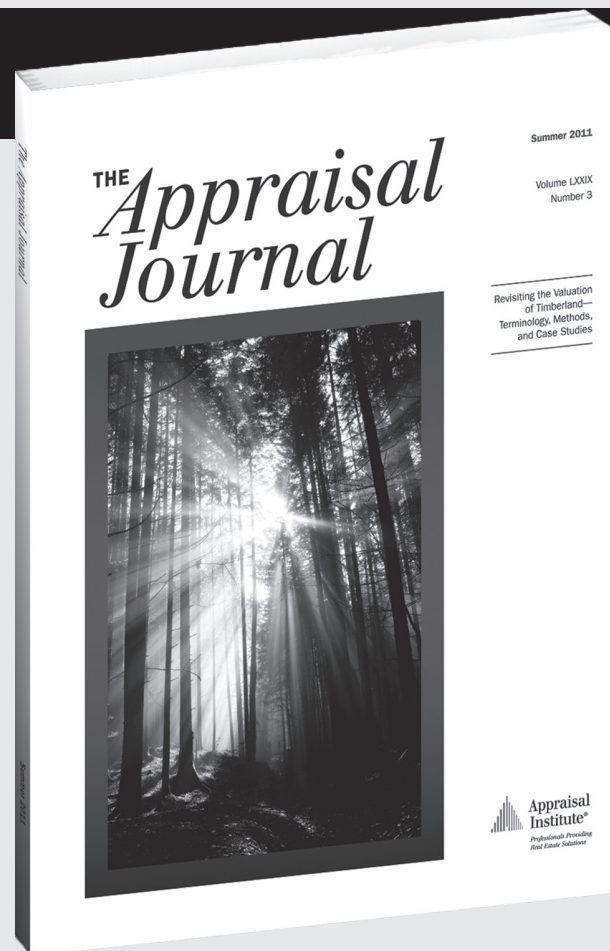
